
## 2007 GM CLAMP INSTRUCTIONS FOR CARGO MANAGEMENT SYSTEM


## CAUTION Incorrect clamping can cause damage to the vehicle. Clamp ONLY where TWO layers of sheet metal are present. Do not over tighten clamps. Correct Clamping locations: Place clamps in the locations shown below. See owners manual for positioning the side rails

correct Clamping locations: Place clamps in the locations snown below. See owners manual for positioning the side rails correctly. With side rail held in place, insert clamp horizontally between the cargo rail and bottom of bed rail. Using a socket with extension, tighten the clamps securely. If your truck has factory or aftermarket side rail protectors see detail A & B below.



2 Next install the TruXedo rail. Refer to the owners manual for correct position of the rail front to back. Hold rail level while clamping.

**NOTE:** We recommend additional help to hold rail in position while installing clamps. A socket extension is recommended for tightening clamps.
