

## Instructions; Raptor 700 '06-'08 Front Lowering Kit

**Part Number 20-1070** 




Note: Make sure you have received a complete kit. The picture (top left) shows all the parts and how they go together.

1) Raise the front end of the quad so the front wheels are off the ground.



- 2) Remove the upper shock bolts on both sides and swing the shock away from mounting bracket.
- 3) Install the kit bracket and bushings in the original shock mounting holes using the stock nut and bolt. Be sure to position the lowering bracket.



4) Be sure to position lowering bracket against the front of the shock mount bracket and bushings against the back. Do not tighten the bolts at this time. 5) Reinstall the shock in the desired mounting holes using the supplied hardware. 6) Lower the bike, tighten all bolts and check suspension for binding. Note-Due to manufacturing variances, it may be necessary to bore bracket mounting holes for proper fit.

This is how your lowering kit should look when you're done! ▶ Bounce front up & down, check for binding!
