- **Step 1:** (Read instructions prior to installation) Secure vehicle on jack stands (refer to your owner's manual for specified jack stand positions.
- **Step 2:** Disconnect the battery.
- **Step 3:** Remove all spark plugs, boots and wires.
- **Step 4:** Remove 15mm bolt on dipstick tube, remove dipstick tube.
- **Step 5:** Remove (x4) of the (x6) bolts (on both sides) of the stock manifold. (Note: leave the remaining (x2) bolts in place to hold the manifold in place.)
- **Step 6:** Support transmission securely and remove the (x1) 15mm nut that holds the crossmember to the transmission and the (x4) bolts and nuts that hold the cross member.
- **Step 7:** Remove the crossmember.
- **Step 8:** Remove primary and secondary 02 sensors.
- **Step 9:** Remove the (x6)13mm nuts that hold the y-pipe to the manifolds and the 13mm 2-1/2" clamp on the back of the y-pipe.
- **Step 10:** Remove y-pipe and stock manifold.
- **Step 11:** Clean cylinder head free of debris

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- **Step 12:** Install left aFe header using the O.E manifold gasket and bolts. (the OE manifold gasket can be re-used if not damaged, replace if necessary)
- **Step 13:** Install right aFe header using the O.E manifold gasket and bolts. (the OE manifold gasket can be re-used if not damaged, replace if necessary)
- Step 14: Tighten both headers starting from the middle bolts and working your way out.
- Step 15: Install all spark plugs, boots and wires.
- **Step 16:** Install driver side y-pipe to passenger side y-pipe using provided 3" band clamps. (Do not tighten at this time.)
- **Step 17:** Install provided 3" band clamps on the ends of the y-pipe and install y-pipe to the headers.
- **Step 18:** Using the OE ball flange clamp, install the y-pipe to the OE exhaust system.
- Step 19: Re-install all 02 sensors.
- Step 20: Re-install crossmember.
- **Step 21:** Tighten all clamps and double check work.
- Step 22: Re-connect battery
- **Step 22:** Congratulations, your installation is now complete. It is recommended to re-tighten all exhaust components after 50-100 miles.
