

PERFORMANCE EXHAUST 2008 Ford Super Duty 6.4L Powerstroke Diesel Extended Cab Short & Long Bed, Crew Cab Short & Long Bed

Removal of stock system:

1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.

2. Loosen the nut on the band clamp located behind the particulate filter using a 15mm wrench or socket. **Refer to Figure 1**.

3. Cut the exhaust as shown in **Figure 2.** Remove the muffler and tail pipe from the OEM rubber insulators. Remove from the vehicle.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

1. The **3.5**" to **5**" Extension Pipe provided is pre-cut for the Super Cab long bed configuration. Cut the **3.5**" to **5**" Extension Pipe to length if required for the vehicle being installed to. **Refer to Figure 3** for measurements.



2. Slide the **3.5**" **Clamp** over the **3.5**" **to 5**" **Extension Pipe** and install it to the particulate filter. Refer to Figure 4. Add the **Extension Pipe** and **5**" **Clamp** if installing on a Crew Cab long Bed.

3. Slide the **5**" **Clamp** onto the end of the **Over Axle Pipe** onto the **Extension Pipe**. Install the **Over Axle Pipe** hangers into the OEM rubber insulators. The clamp should remain loose enough for adjustability. **Refer to Figure 5**.

4. Slide the Tail Pipe onto the Over Axle Pipe using a 5" Clamp.

5. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit. Tighten the lock bolt located on the **Exhaust Tip**.

6. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.

7. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If there is any interference, detected relocate or adjust.
