

# Removal of Stock System

## Note: Installation requires cutting the OEM Exhaust

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Disconnect the wiring from the exhaust actuators located on both the driver and passenger side of the OEM exhaust. **Refer to Figure 1.**
- 3. Using a Sawsall or similar, cut the OEM pipes so they are flush with the **REAR** vertical surface on the rear suspension crossmember.

Refer to Figures 2 and 3.

4. Remove the nuts from the rear muffler hangers. With the help of an assistant, remove the front muffler hangers and lower the OEM muffler assembly. Retain the brackets and hardware as these will be reused.

Refer to Figure 4.

5. Unbolt and remove the Actuators. Retain the hardware as it will be reused.

### Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust

- 1. Install the Actuators onto the supplied **Actuator Brackets** using the previously removed hardware. **Refer to Figure 6.**
- 2. Remove the 2 fasteners securing the heat shield to the rear facia and install the **Actuator Bracket** between them. Reinstall the fasteners and connect the wiring. Repeat on the opposite side. **Refer to Figure 7.**
- 3. Install the **Driver-Side Extension Pipe** by first installing a **2.75" Clamp** over the inlet before installing it onto the OEM pipe. Install the pipe with approximately 1.5" of overlap. Leave it angled down slightly to help with the rest of the installation. **Refer to Figure 8**.

- 4. Install the OEM rear muffler hanger onto the **Driver-Side Tailpipe** as shown. Install a **3" Clamp** onto the inlet. **Refer to Figure 9.**
- 5. Install the **Driver-Side Tailpipe** onto the **Driver-Side Extension Pipe**. Once fully seated, rotate both assemblies up into position before installing the rear muffler hanger and securing with the previously removed nuts. **Refer to Figures 10, 11, and 12.**
- 6. Reinstall the front muffler hanger onto the **Driver-Side Extension Pipe**.
- 7. Repeat steps 3-6 for the passenger-side components.
- 8. Install the **Tips** and align the system to center them in the rear fascia. Tighten all clamps and inspect for proper clearance between any wiring and hoses.
